#### GUIDE TO LOYOLA (Located in the City of Green)

##### From Cleveland Area:

Take 77 south towards Canton to Arlington Road Exit, turn right onto Arlington, proceed south to the 5300 block of Arlington to Killinger Road, turn right on Killinger and go about 3/4 mile to our driveway on the left.

##### From Canton Area:

Take 77 north towards Akron to the Portage Road Exit, turn left (heading west) to Arlington Road and turn right. Continue approximately 3.5 miles and turn left onto Killinger and go about 3/4 mile to our driveway on the left.

He is currently the Pastor of St. Paul on the Lake in Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan where he has served since 2003.
