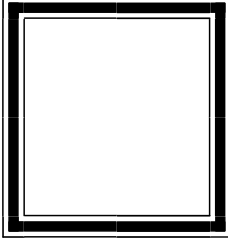

DIRECTIONS TO LOYOLA

From Cleveland Area:

Take 77 south towards Canton to Arlington Road Exit, turn right onto Arlington, proceed south about 5 3/4 miles to Killinger Road, turn right on Killinger and go about 3/4 mile to our driveway on the left.

From Canton Area: Take 77N towards Akron to the Portage Street exit. Turn left onto Portage and proceed west; turn right onto Arlington Road. Proceed north on Arlington Road for approximately 3-1/2 miles. Turn Left onto Killinger Road and go approximately 3/4 mile to our driveway on the left.

PAUL AND KATHY WEBER have been members of St. Paul Parish in North Canton. They are both Secular Discalced Carmelites and work with isolated Carmelites in Ohio and surrounding states.
